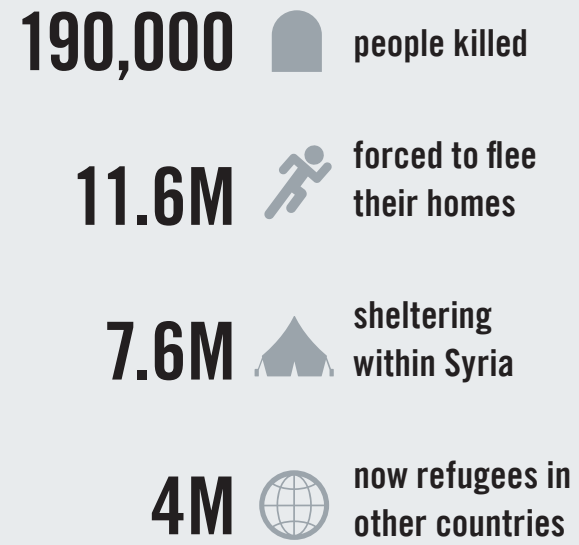
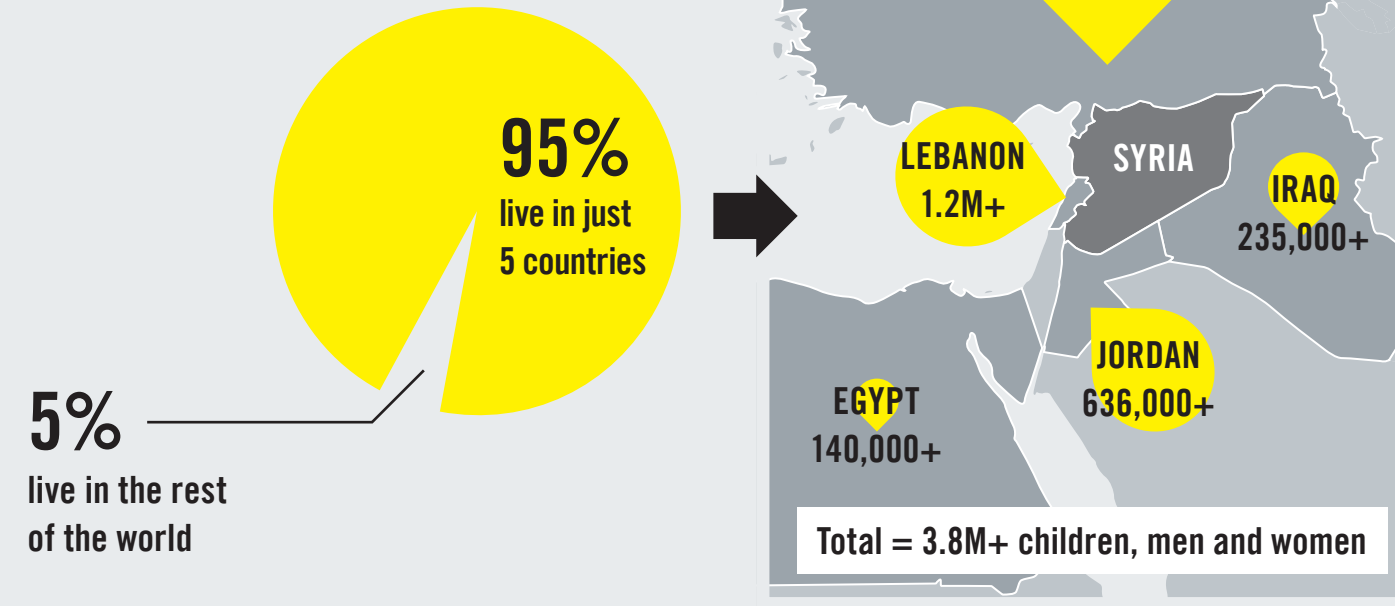

Resettlement = giving vulnerable refugees a life-changing opportunity to start new lives abroad.

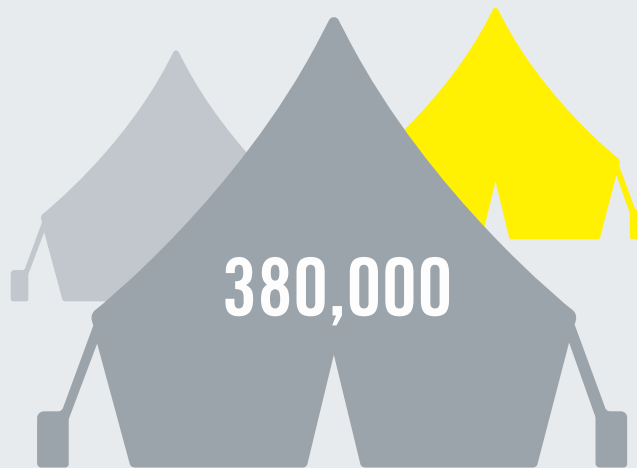
(The international community agreed this solution after World War II, to share responsibility for refugees and help out countries hosting huge numbers).
